Grace and peace to you all.

Kevin Tengvall is preaching in Merredin today and will discuss the topic "God's Relevance Today". Church attendance in Australia in particular, and across the western world more generally, has been falling for decades after it peaked in about 1960, and the number of people who describe themselves as non-religious has never been higher. Has the idea of God outlived its usefulness?

I think the answer is no, of course! The curious thing is that many of those people who claim to be non-religious claim nevertheless to be spiritual. That is, they recognise something, or someone, outside themselves that gives their lives meaning and gives themselves strength to live their lives. Many of these spiritual beliefs and practices are intensely personal and the corporate worship and sometimes dry theological debate of the institutional church does not resonate.

But are the unorthodox concepts of God and

his dealings with humanity that abound today helpful? There is no doubt that left to our own devices humanity can make a pretty awful mess of things. Quite apart from the continuing violence and military conflict in many parts of the world, there is increasing economic and personal hardship in Australia as people who can afford to be compassionate become less so, and those at the margins of our society become more desperate.

It's no coincidence that Kevin has chosen the passage in Luke's gospel about loving your enemies and turning the other cheek this morning. This is an aspect of Jesus's teaching that is lost too often in our dealings with and attitudes to other people. God is relevant today because it is only when we glimpse him through Jesus that we realise how we are to live—with compassion and love for all—and we are given the strength to do it.
